

## **CONSTRUCTION EXECUTIVE TO HEAD UDOT**

Gov. Mike Leavitt on Friday appointed Salt Lake construction executive W. Craig Zwick to head the Utah Department of Transportation.

Mr. Zwick, 45, is a lifelong Utahn who will "bring leadership and motivation" to the department, Mr. Leavitt said. Mr. Zwick is vice president of Okland Construction Co.

He will replace Eugene S. Findlay, who has been director for the past six years.

Mr. Zwick will take over reins of a department short on funds and faced with deteriorating roads and bridges. The department is also attempting to consolidate regional operations under a mandate that is unpopular in many rural communities.

Mr. Zwick is a University of Utah graduate in finance and business. He was a building contractor who helped construct 70 major buildings including the Salt Lake County Complex, Little America Hotel in Wyoming, the Salt Lake LDS Genealogical Library and the Portland, Ore., LDS Temple.

He served as president of the Santiago, Chile, LDS Mission until last year. Mr. Zwick was formerly associated with CraCar construction.
