Gary B. Doxey has been named general counsel to Gov. Mike Leavitt.

An assistant professor of history at Brigham Young University, Doxey replaces Robin Riggs.

Leavitt said Doxey ``brings a great mix of talent and experience to this office."

As general counsel, Doxey will advise the governor on legal issues and track legislation.

Doxey previously spent four years as associate general counsel to the Legislature.

He has a doctoral degree in history from Cambridge University and a law degree from BYU.
